# Conditionals: If sentences: zero conditional



Note: Conditionals about the present and past are impossible. Conditionals about the future are possible

If you study hard, you get better results.

If you heat water, it boils.

Zero (0) Conditional

Always true (NOT: past/present/future)

Present tense in if clause. Present tense in main clause.

# Conditionals: If sentences: zero conditional



Examples: Zero (0) Conditional

1. If you heat water to 100 degrees, it boils.
2. If I eat too much sugar, I feel sick.
3. If you mix blue and yellow, you get green.
4. If the sun shines, it feels warm.
5. If you don't water plants, they die.
6. If you squeeze an orange, you get juice.
7. If you don't eat, you get hungry.
8. If you push something, it moves.
