Conditionals: If sentences: Mixed Conditionals



Note: Conditionals about the present and past are impossible. Conditionals about the future are possible

If I had studied harder at school, I would have a better job now.

Mixed Conditional
past / present

Third Conditional in if clause. Second Conditional in main clause.

Conditionals: If sentences: Mixed Conditionals



Examples: Mixed Conditional: 3rd conditional (past) and 2nd conditional (present)

1. If I had started sooner, the project would be finished now.
2. If she hadn't changed jobs so often, she would be earning more money now.
3. If he had eaten more at lunch time, he would not be hungry now.
4. If we had gone to the concert last night, we would be tired today.
5. If you had studied harder, you would be better at English now.
6. If I had taken the job, I would be living in New York now.
