Similarities: A and B are similar in that...

1. Useful for making comparisons and organising data.
2. Grouping by similarities and differences.
3. Flexible: May be used in paragraphs 2 (main point), or 3 and 4 – details.
4. Another sentence without errors.

Yemen and Italy are similar in that the percentage of the population that is over 60 is forecast to rise significantly. However, the actual percentage is predicted to still be dramatically different – far smaller in Yemen than Italy.

(A) is /are / were similar in that

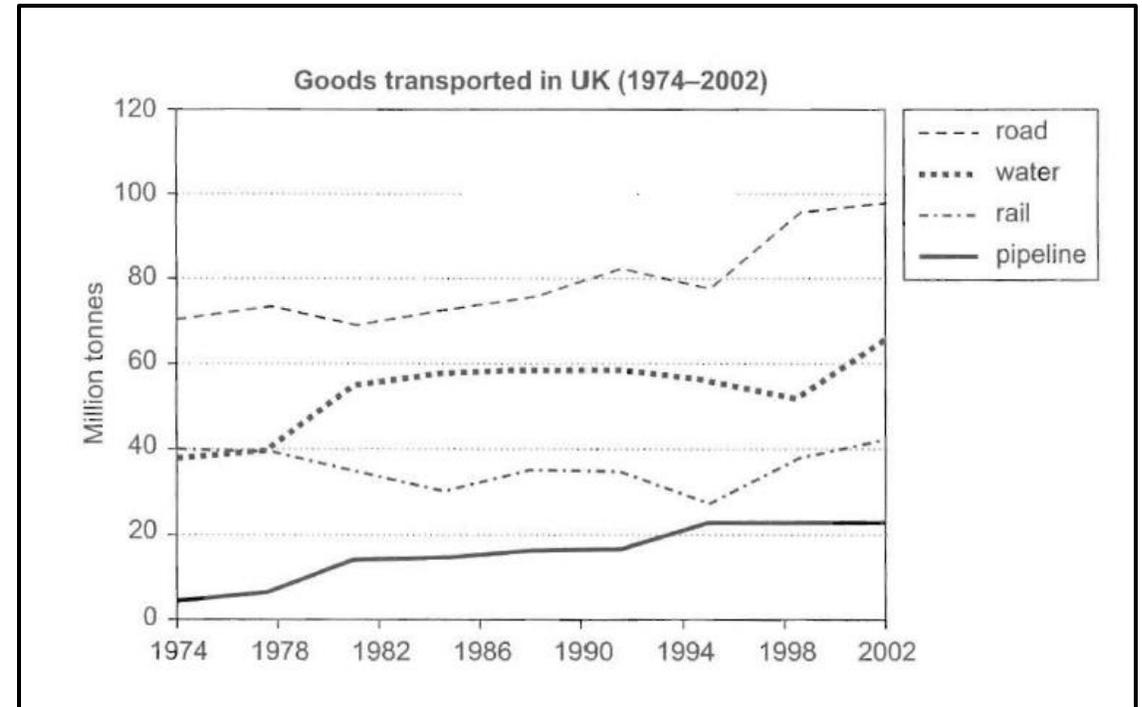
- All age groups are similar in that... (more than 2 age groups)

- with the exception of... exclude a particular group / time from the similarity

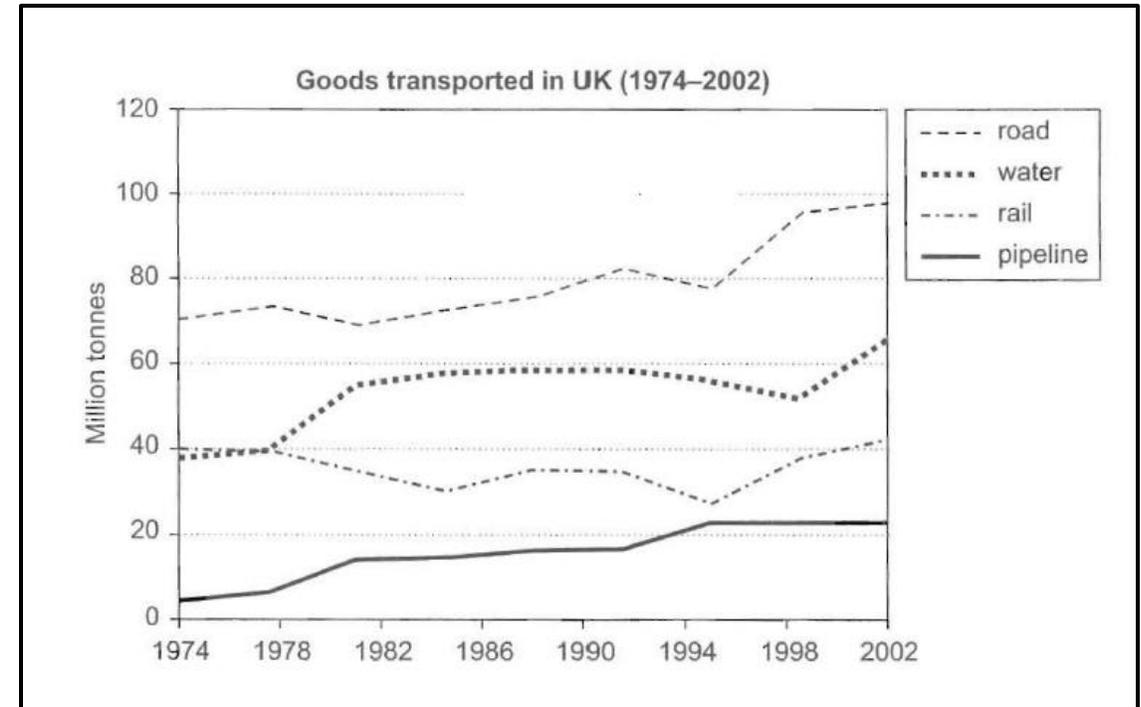

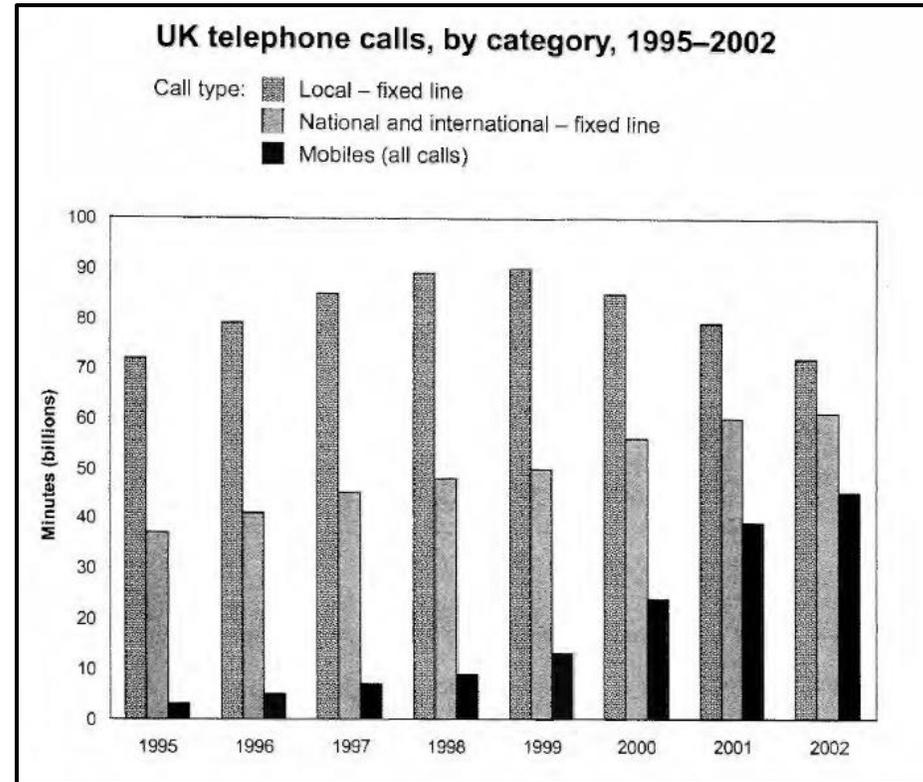
Road, water, pipeline - similar - increased – this period

2. Transport by road, water and pipeline were similar in that the quantity carried rose very substantially during this period.

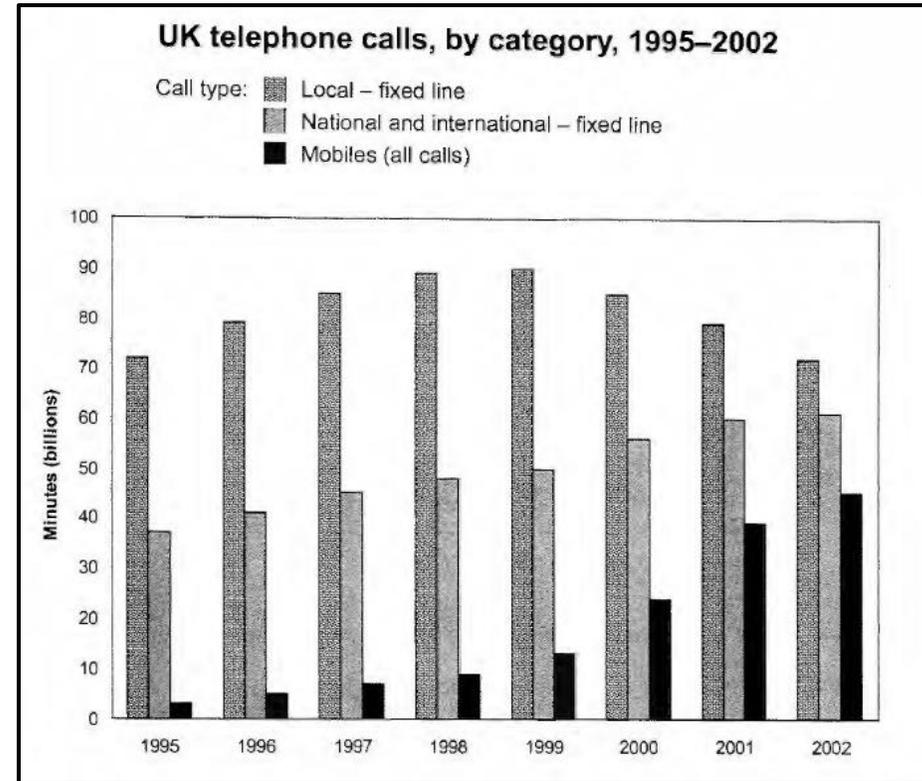

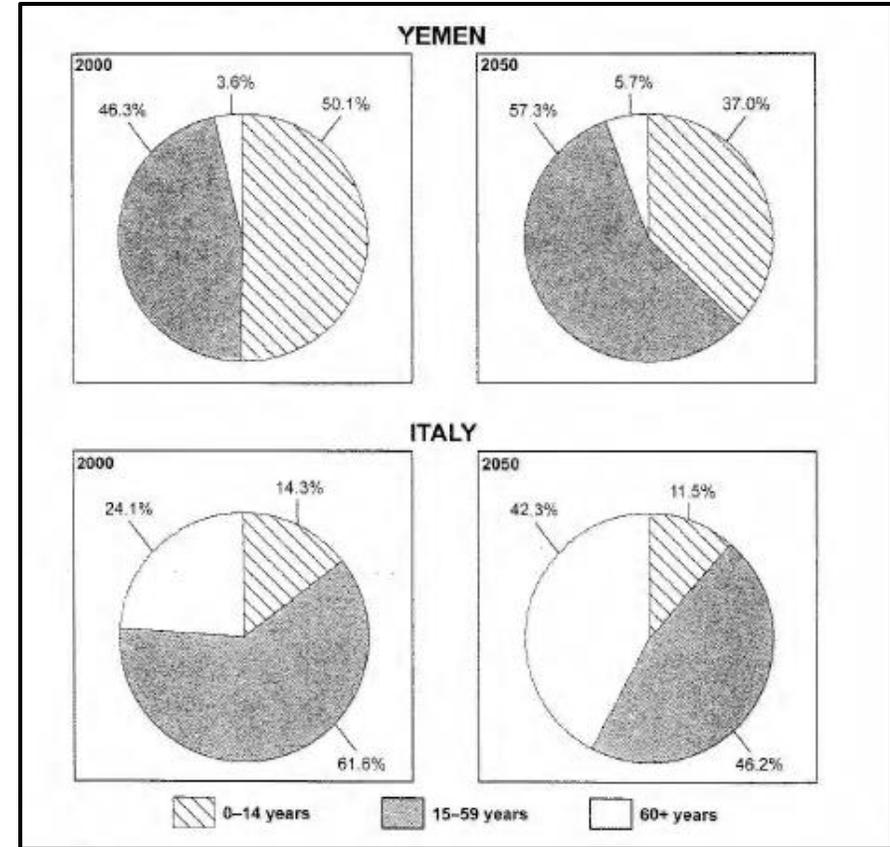
National and international fixed line calls, mobile calls – increased 1995 to 2002



National and international fixed line calls and mobile calls are similar in that they both increased continuously throughout the entire 7 year period from 1995 to 2002.

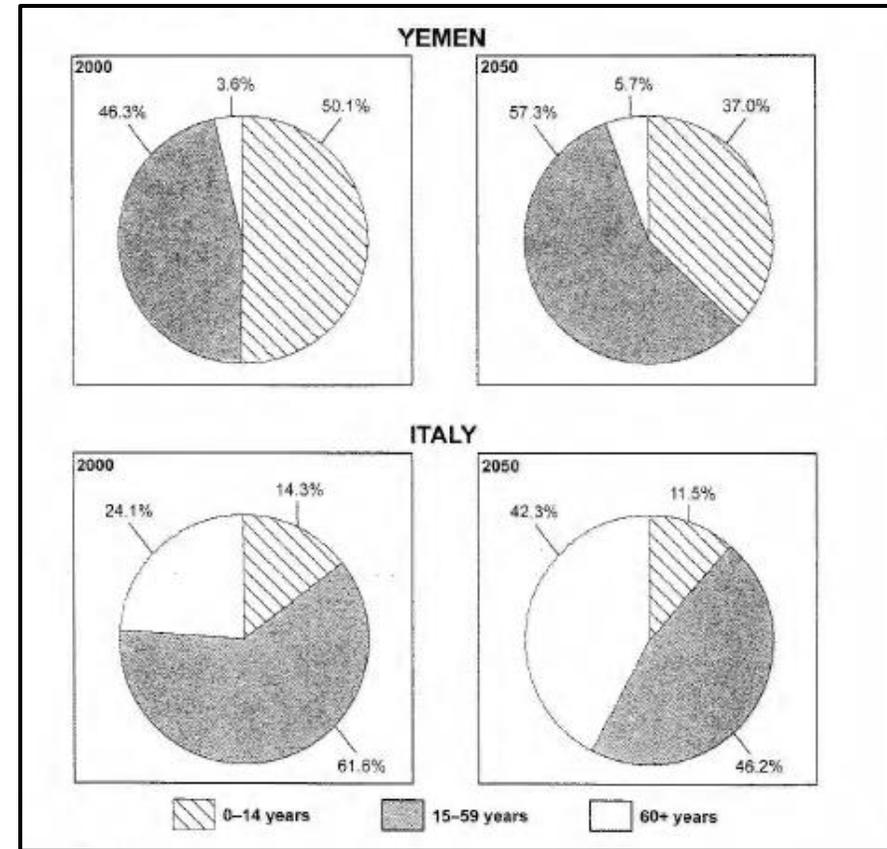

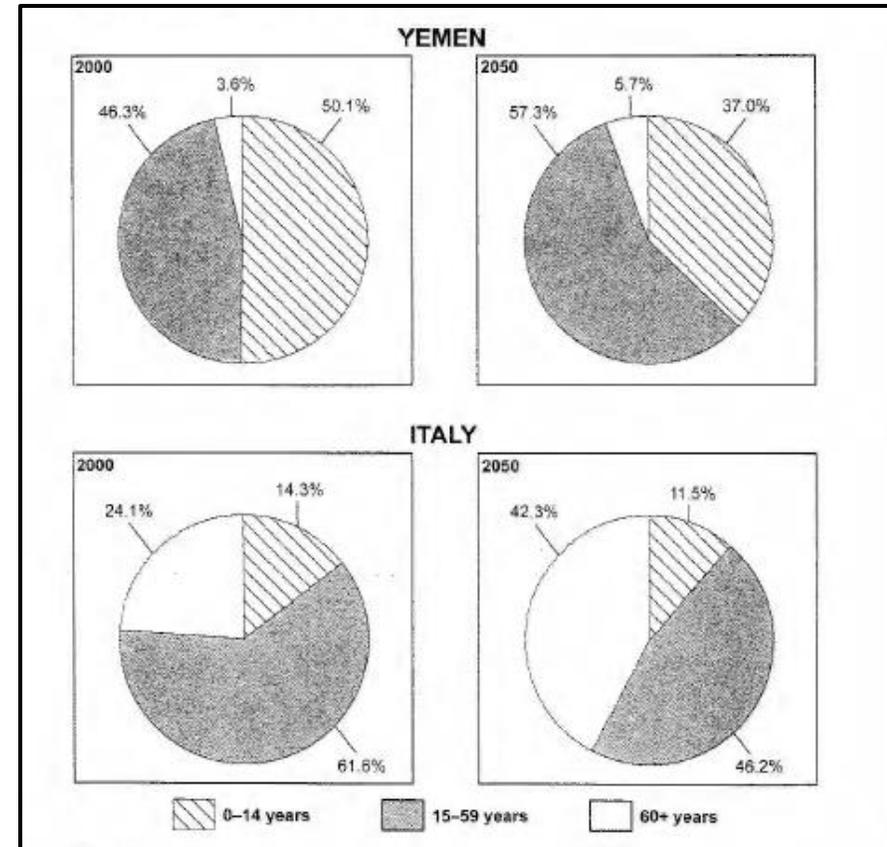

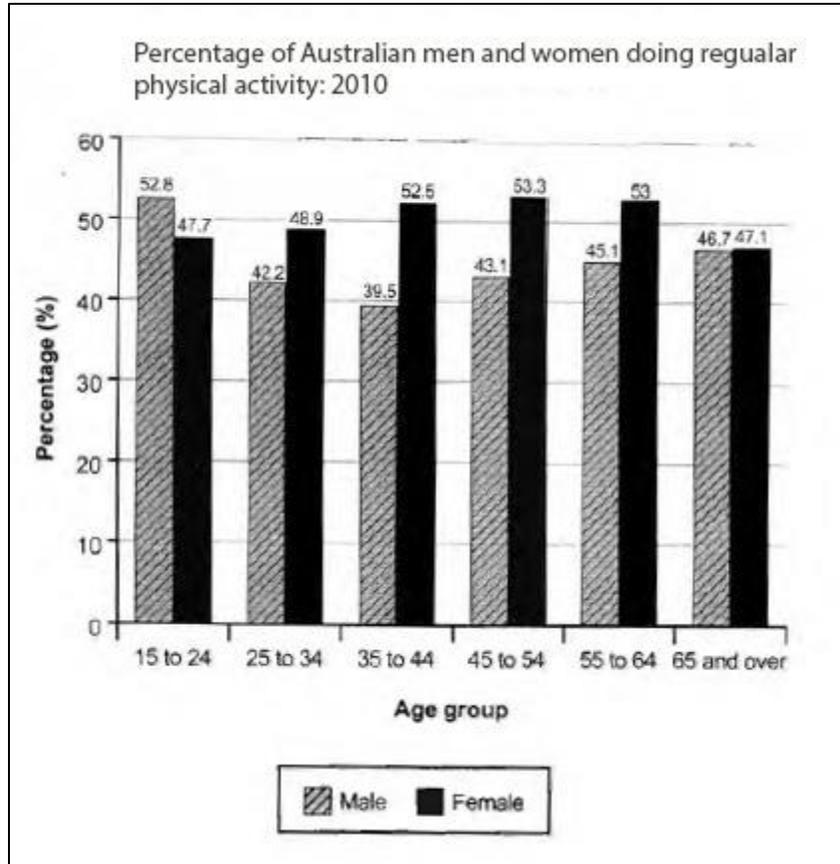
Yemen and Italy – 0-14 fall & 60+ rise - 2000 to 2050

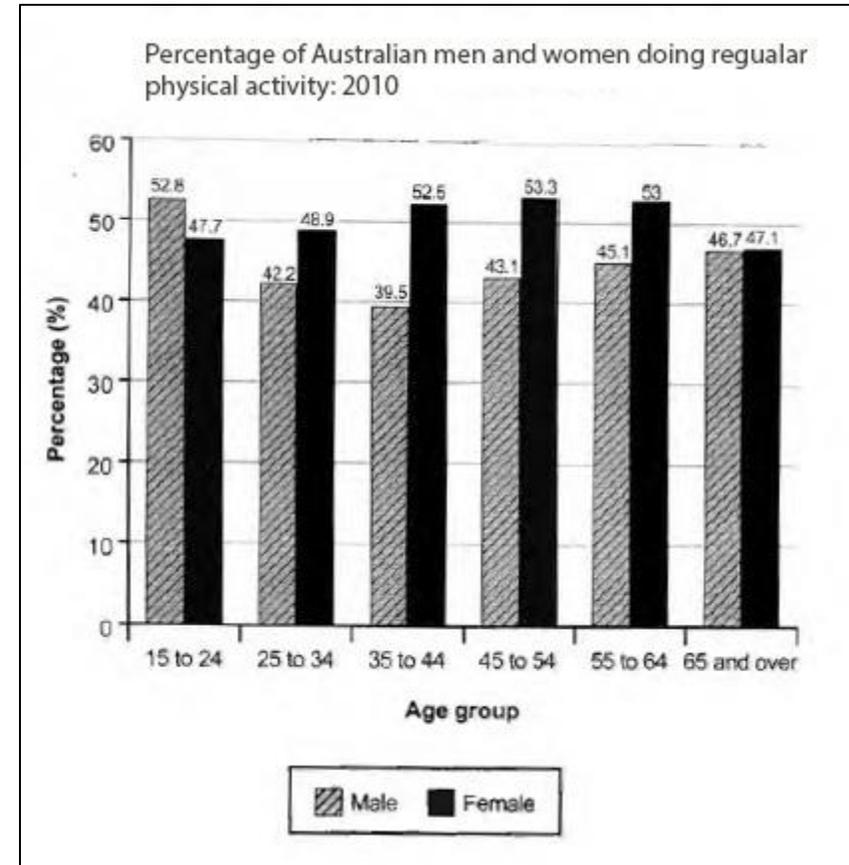

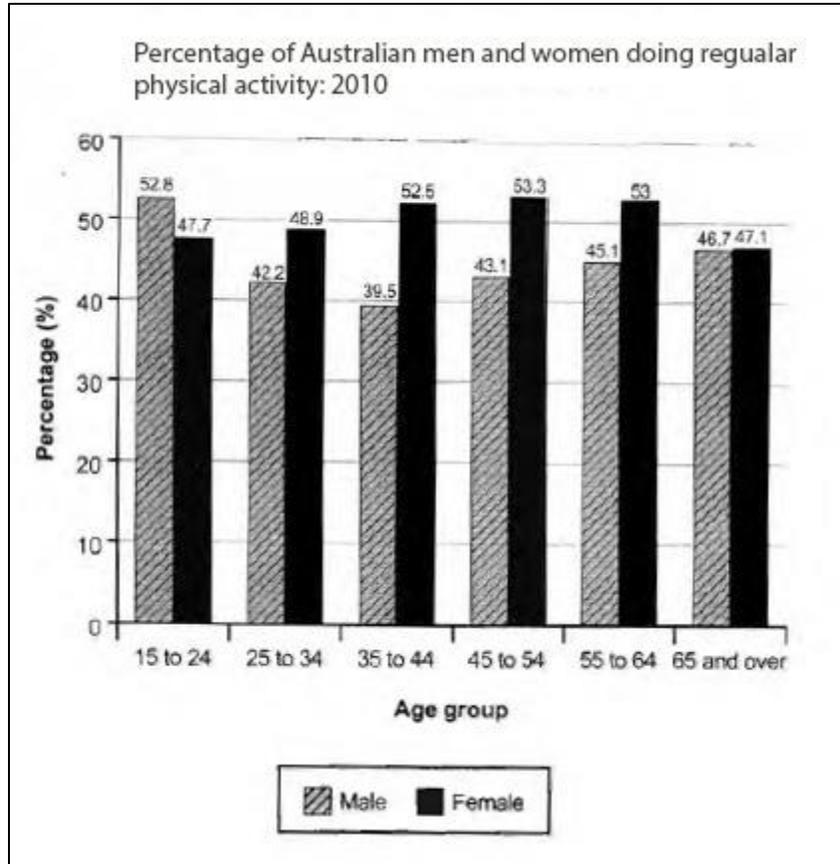
All 6 age groups – similar - percentage men and women exercise - quite narrow range - between low point – 40% - peak - 53%.



All six age groups were similar in that the percentage of men and women who did regular exercise was in a quite narrow range between a low point of just under 40% and a peak of approximately 53%.

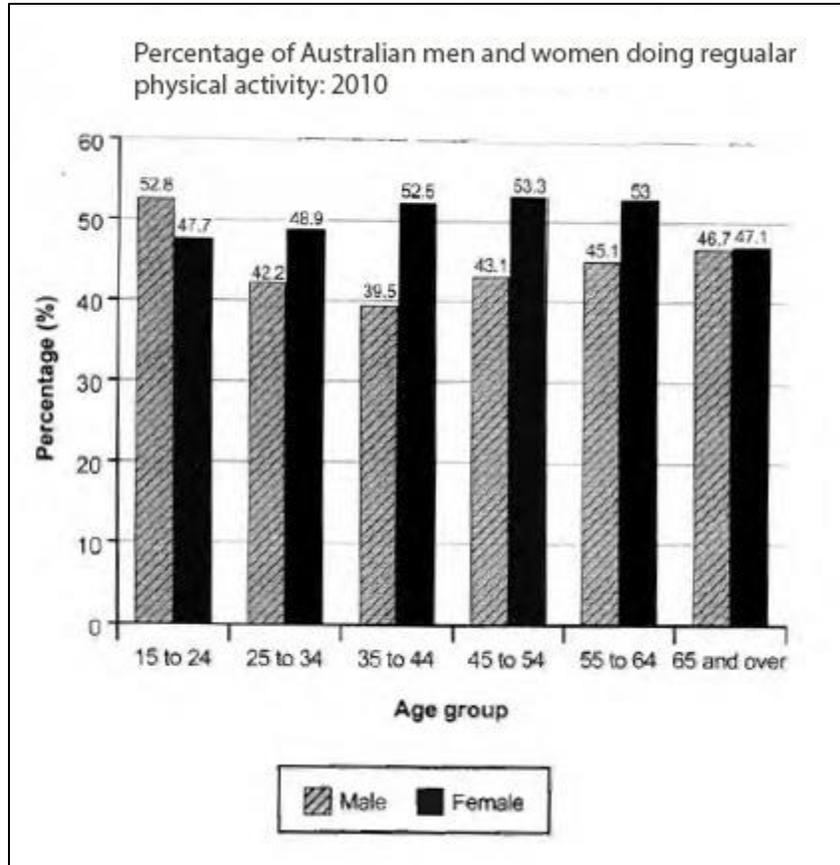

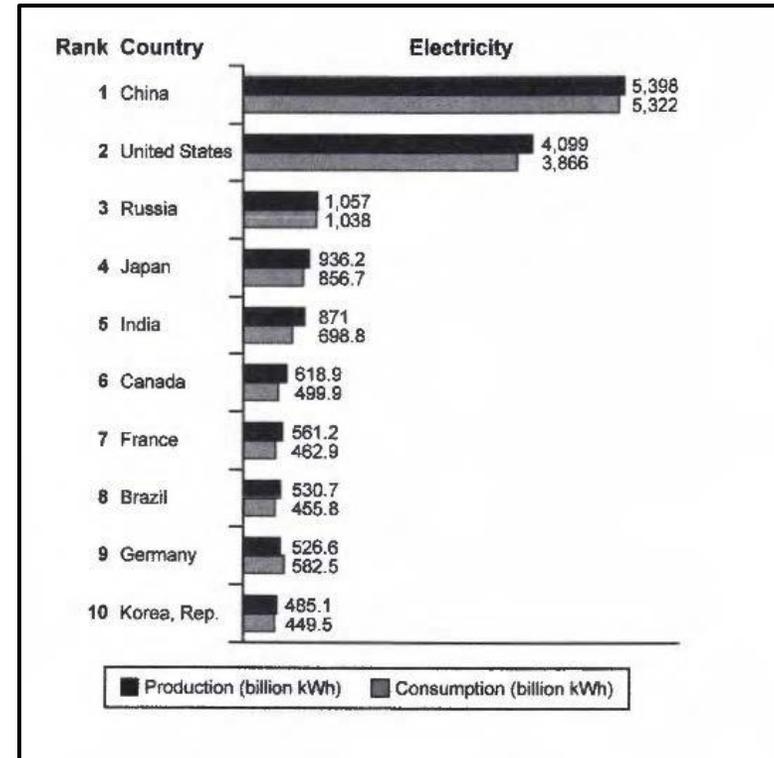

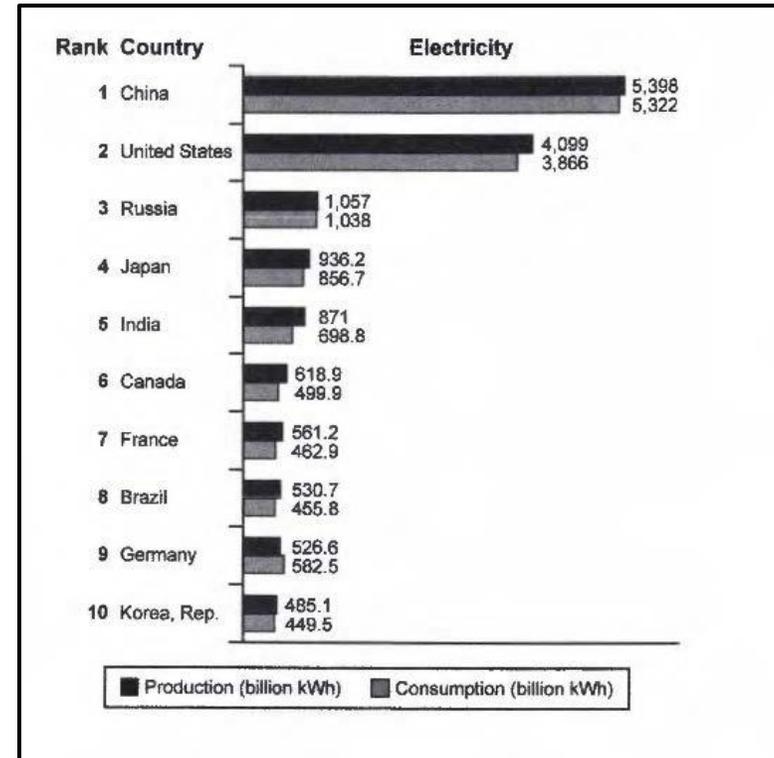

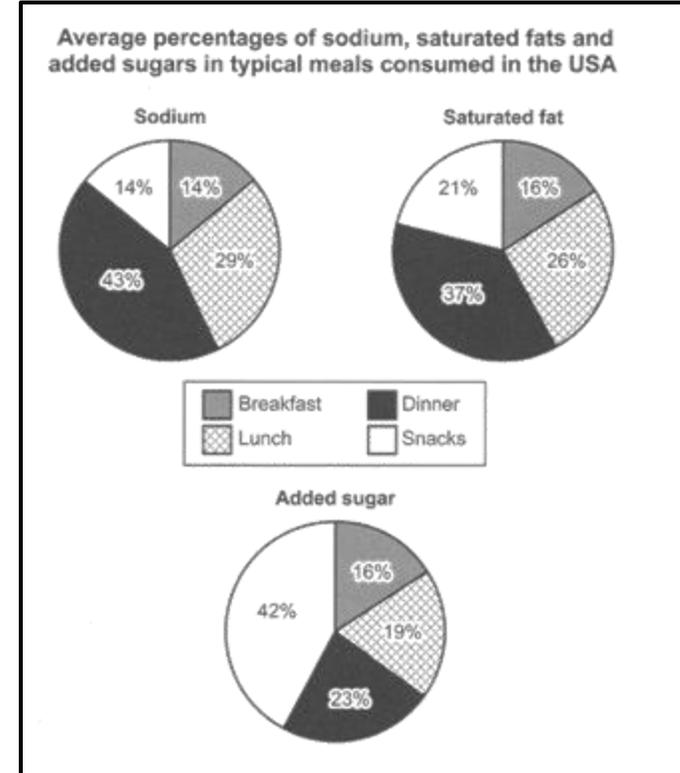
All 10 countries - except Germany - are similar – electricity production – slightly greater – electricity consumption



All ten countries, with the exception of Germany, are similar in that the amount of electricity that was produced was slightly greater than the amount that was consumed.

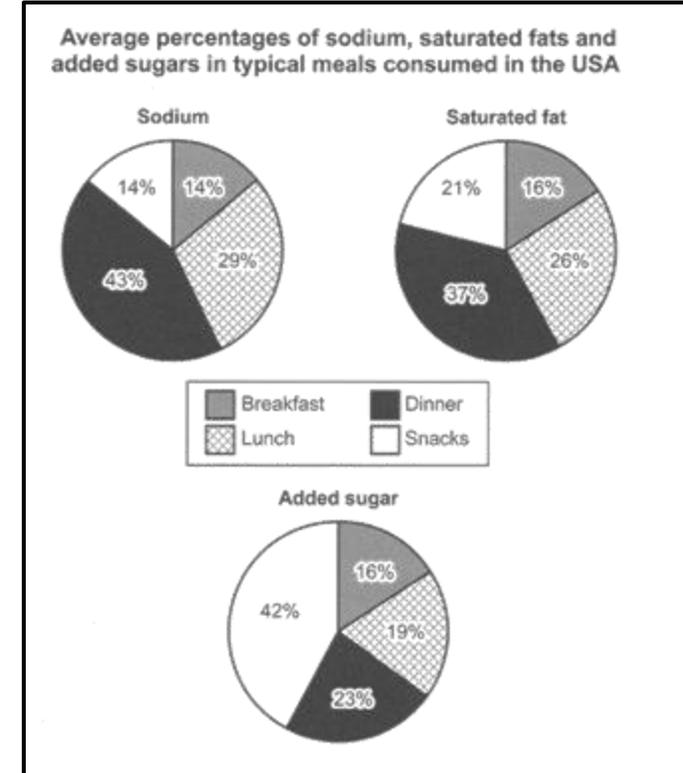
Q7

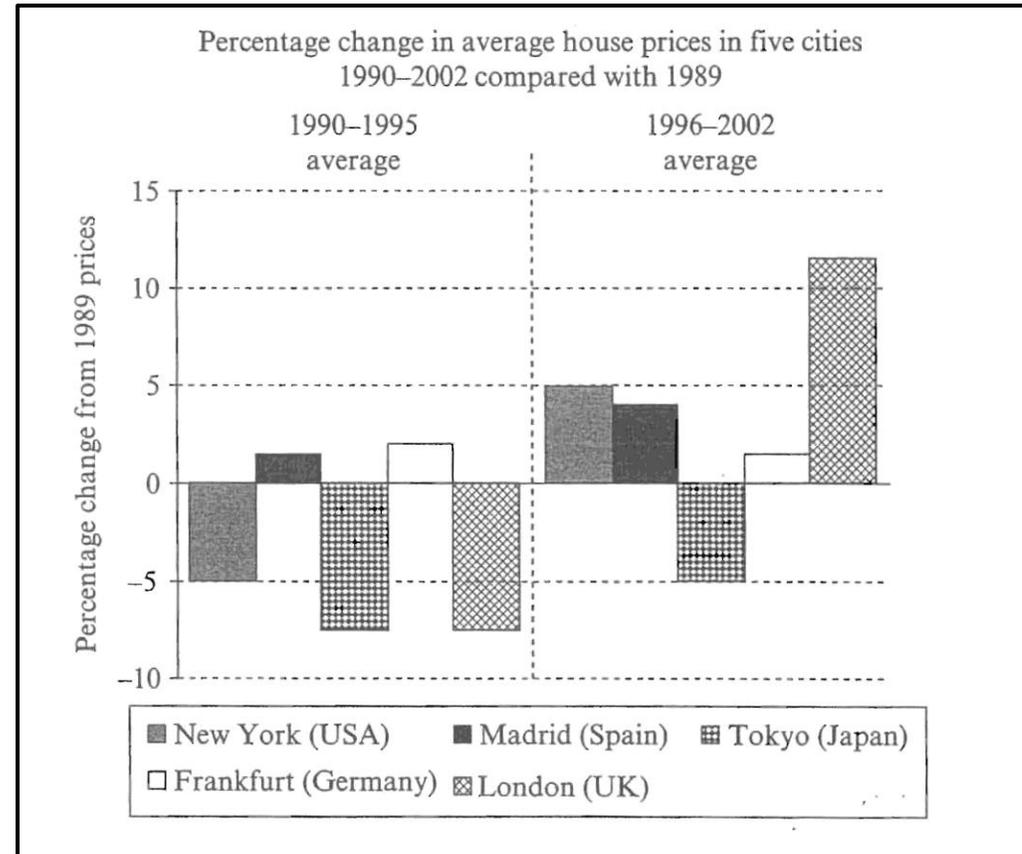

2. All five countries are similar in that the percentage of total spending (that people) spent on food, drink and tobacco was the largest of the three categories of spending and leisure and education the smallest.

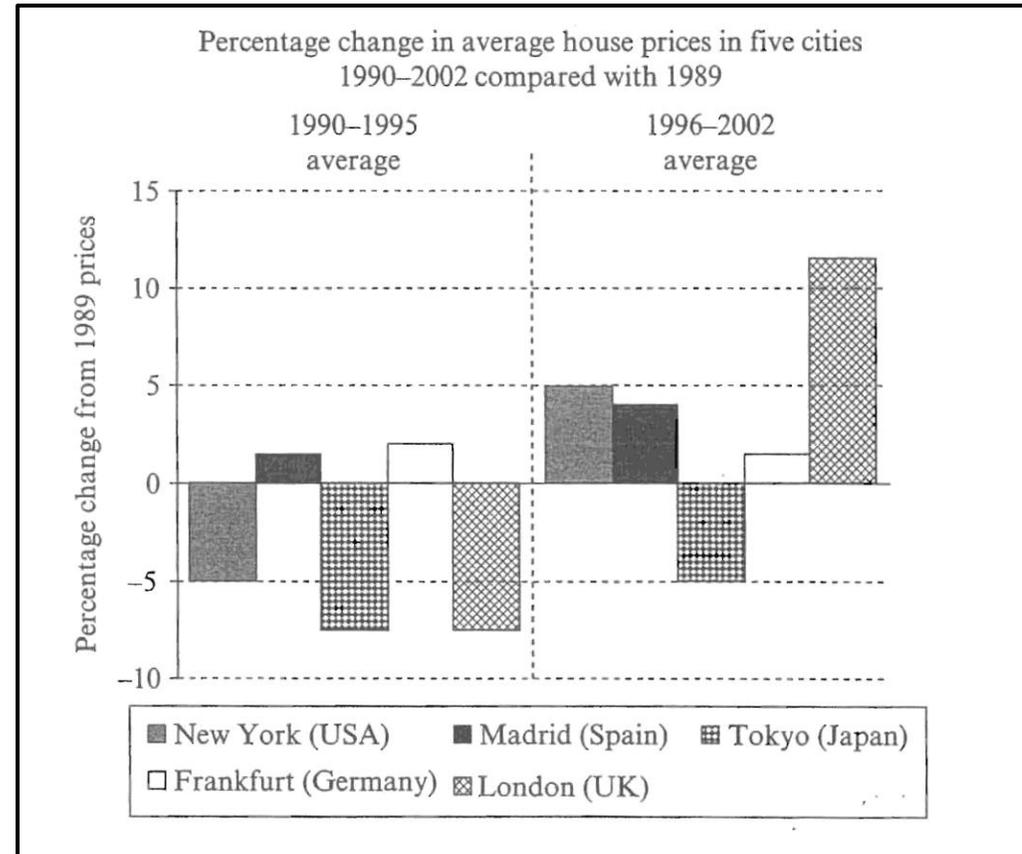

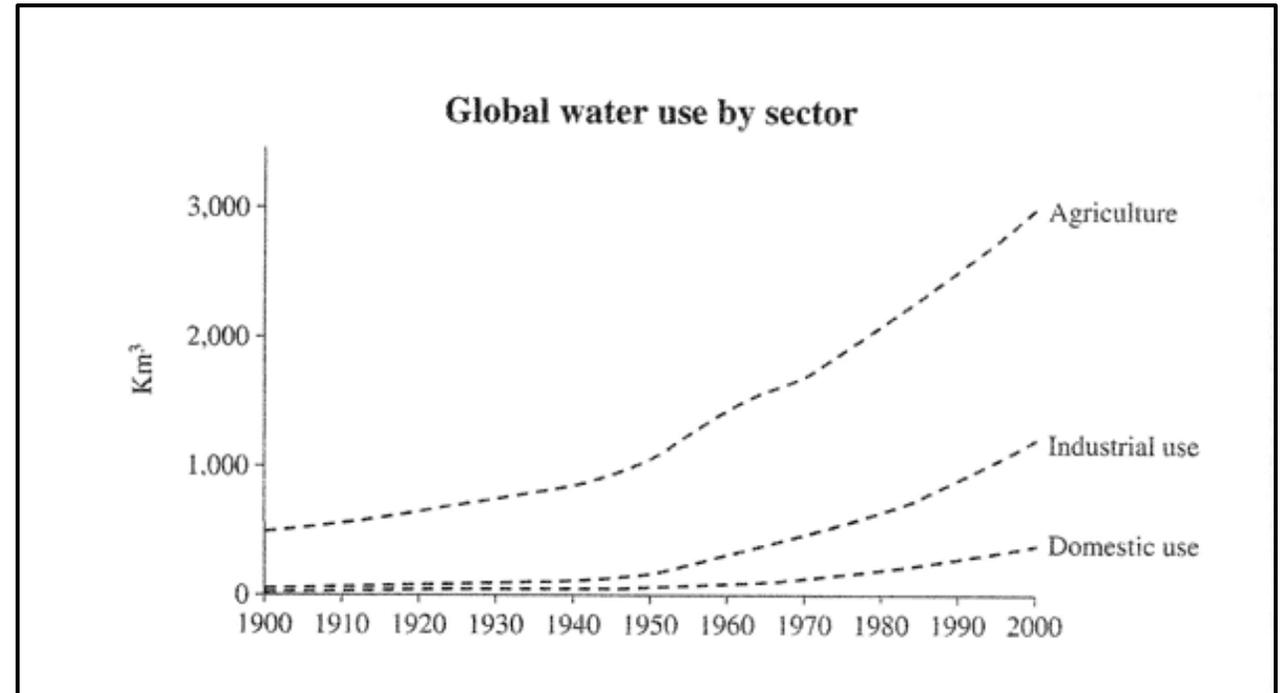
Madrid & Frankfurt – similar - house prices higher - both periods – compared with 1989



Madrid and Frankfurt are similar in that average house prices were higher in both cities, in both periods, compared with 1989.

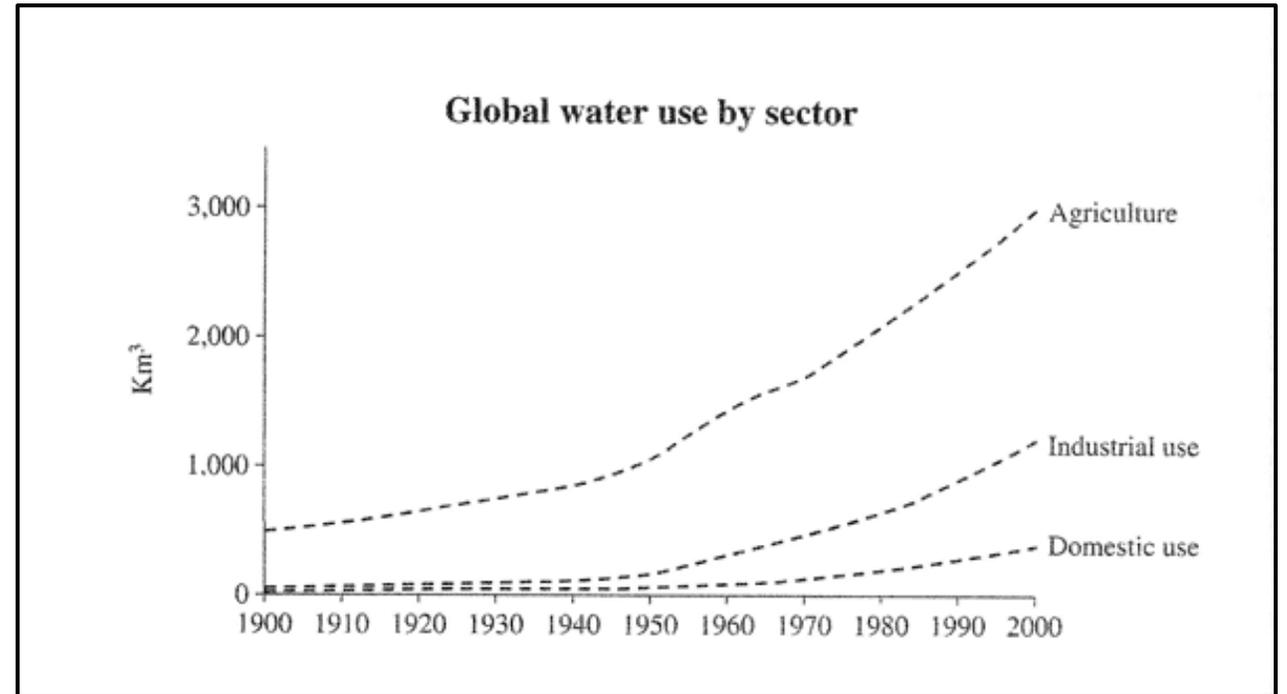
Q10
